MINUTES – Draft

**1. Call to Order**

Chairman Sharp called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

**2. Approval of the October 18, 2012 Meeting Minutes**

Upon a motion by Kim Payne to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Will Mays, the minutes of October 18, 2012 were unanimously approved.

**3. Public Hearing and Consideration and Approval of an Amendment to the Central Virginia Transportation Improvement Program Fiscal Years 2012-2015 (CVTIP FY 2012-2015)**

Chairman Sharp opened the Public Hearing at 4:03 p.m., and with no public comments, proceeded in course.

Bob White detailed the amendment and provided a summary of changes. Additionally, Bob detailed the new identified projects.

Upon a motion by Kim Payne to approve the resolution, seconded by David Laurrell, the resolution was unanimously approved as presented.

**4. Public Hearing and discussion of the Development of the Central Virginia Metropolitan Planning Organization’s Title VI Plan and related Public Participation Plan for the Central Virginia Metropolitan Planning Organization Amendment**

Chairman Sharp opened the floor to public comment, and with no public comments, proceeded in course.

Bob White detailed the Title IV plan and the initiative to ensure compliance with the federal transportation requirements relating to anti-discrimination. Bob noted that as a result, the Public Participation Plan needs to be amended. No Public comments were received for the public hearing on the Title VI Plan in the October 18, 2012 meeting. Further, Bob noted that the Transportation Technical Committee has recommended approval of these items.

Upon a motion by David Laurrell to approve the resolutions, seconded by Will Mays, the resolutions were unanimously approved as presented.

**5. Consideration and Approval of an Amendment to the Central Virginia Metropolitan Planning Organization’s Unified Planning Work Program, Fiscal Year 2013**

Bob White detailed the UPWP FY13 and the amendment to allow for the reprogramming of project funding. Bob mentioned that these funds would allow for the update to the Central Virginia Long Range Transportation Plan which would include engaging a

consultant for the project. Bob noted that the Transportation Technical Committee has reviewed the UPWP FY13 and recommends the amendment.

Upon a motion by Jock Hobbs to approve the resolution to amend, seconded by Will Mays, the resolution was unanimously approved as presented.

**6. Consideration and Approval of the Central Virginia Metropolitan Planning Organization's Unified Planning Work Program, Fiscal Year 2014**

Bob White detailed the Central Virginia Metropolitan Planning Organization's Unified Planning Work Program for FY 2014. Bob noted the various projects that are included in the document including the update to the Central Virginia Long Range Transportation Plan, continued efforts in alternative transportation, and planning assistance to the GLTC. Bob noted that the Transportation Technical Committee has reviewed the document and recommends the UPWP be adopted.

Upon a motion by Will Mays to approve the resolution to adopt the UPWP FY14, seconded by Kim Payne, the resolution was unanimously approved as presented.

**7. Consideration of Support for the Central Virginia Area Agency on Aging's and Horizon Behavioral Health's Federal Transit Administration Funding Requests**

Bob White discussed the two grant applications through the FTA submitted by CVAAA and Horizon. Bob noted that the Transportation Technical Committee has reviewed and recommends approval of these requests.

Upon a motion by David Laurrell to approve the resolution for the grant requests, seconded by Kim Payne, the resolution was unanimously approved as presented.

**8. Consideration and Approval of the Region 2000 Greenways, Blueways and Trails Plan – 2012 Connection Vision**

Kelly Hitchcock presented the Plan and discussed several aspects of the Plan including the purpose, the listing of priorities and the completion time line vision for the eight identified projects, funding strategies, and how the Plan is intended to be a useful tool for the Region 2000 localities.

Upon a motion by Kim Payne to approve the resolution to adopt the Region 2000 Greenways, Blueways and Trails Plan – 2012 Connection Vision, seconded by Will Mays, the resolution was unanimously approved as presented.

**9. Discussion of Including Liberty University as Part of the Central Virginia Metropolitan Planning Organization**

Bob White opened the discussion with a brief overview of the current MPO structure and that a review of the bylaws allows for the inclusion of non-voting members as appropriate.

Kim Payne further detailed the importance and benefit of including Liberty and discussed, in brief, the City of Lynchburg's interaction and working relationship with Liberty over the course of the time. Kim elaborated on the advantages of establishing a forum for more formalized discussions that included Liberty, and what plans and intentions they may have as they continue to grow and impact the region. Kim mentioned that Liberty has agreed that this would be advantageous and have expressed an interest in being included in the CVMPO. Rick Youngblood of the VDOT Lynchburg District echoed this point and expressly stated that VDOT fully supported this approach and welcomed the frequency with which the MPO would be able to interact with Liberty.

Upon a motion by Kim Payne to accept Liberty University to the CVMPO as a non-voting member in accordance with Article III Section 2 of the CVMPO bylaws, seconded by Will Mays, the resolution was unanimously approved as presented.

**10. Opportunity for Public Comment** - None received

**11. Matters from the Committee**

Marsha Fiol commented on the how well the CVMPO is perceived and congratulated the group on their work and accomplishments.

Rick Youngblood commented on the meeting of the CTB in Lynchburg and that the board members were given a preview of projects in the district. Rick mentioned that the CVMPO was well represented at the meeting and that the presentation by Bob White was well detailed. Rick mentioned that the CTB members seemed well impressed with the projects.

John Sharp and Bob White briefly discussed the funding amendment to the Long Range Transportation Plan and TIP for the Odd Fellows Road construction that would be discussed in a called meeting to take place at 5:00 pm on May 16 just prior to the LGC meeting.

**12. Adjournment-Next meeting of the CVMPO is May 16, 2013, 5:00 p.m.**
