The City of Lynchburg has requested a Resolution of Support by the CVMPO for its pending application to VDOT's Transportation Alternatives Program. The *Lynchpin Sidewalk Plan* is a request for approximately \$200,000 in funding assistance to construct 4,500 feet of sidewalk along Jefferson Ridge Parkway within Lynchpin Industrial Park. This project will provide safe pedestrian movement along the roadway and access to Ivy Creek Park for the approximate 1,400

workers in the industrial park. This project is also part of a longer term vision to expand pedestrian access to the Wiggington Road and Peaks View Park areas.

- 1. Chairman John Sharp called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm
- 2. Approval of the May 16, 2013 Meeting Minutes

Upon a motion by Kim Payne to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Will Mays, the minutes of May 16, 2013 were unanimously approved.

3. Public Hearing and Consideration and Approval of an Amendment to the Central Virginia Transportation Improvement Program Fiscal Years 2012-2015

Bob White presented to the members the suggested amendments made by the Virginia Department of Rails and Public Transportation to the Central Virginia Transportation Improvement Program Fiscal Years 2012-2015 to ensure consistency between the Central Virginia Transportation Improvement Program Fiscal Years 2012-2015 and the Commonwealth's Six Year Improvement Plan. He noted that a 30-day public hearing period was held and no comments were received.

Kim Payne and Lee Beaumont disclosed that they were each members of the Board of the Greater Lynchburg Transit Company.

Public Hearing: Chairman John Sharp opened the Public Meeting at 4:04 p.m. No comments were received. Public Hearing closed at 4:05 p.m.

Upon a motion by Mark Reeter to approve the resolution amending the CVTIP FY 2012-2015, seconded by David Laurrell, the resolution was unanimously approved as presented.

4. Consideration and Approval of the <u>Recommendation for Approval of Functional</u> <u>Classification Changes Proposed by the Virginia Department of Transportation</u>

Bob White presented to the members the recommendations for changes to the functional classification by the Virginia Department of Transportation. Bob White further explained the importance of the functional classification to the CVMPO and the localities. He further noted that the proposed recommended changes were a result of meetings with the technical committee, area planners, traffic engineers and in close coordination with the VDOT Lynchburg district planning staff.

Rick Youngblood offered comments regarding the fiscal impact of the functional class and the applauded the efforts of those that worked closely to the success of the effort.

Clarification was given to the recommendations in the locality recommendation is the consensus of the localities and VDOT district office with the concurrence of the CVMPO. Ivan Rucker explained that when the FHA reviews the recommendations that they look closely to see that consensus was reached and great weight is afforded such consensus as it is in the FHA opinion that the "field knows best".

Further, the record shows that Ivan Rucker, FHA representative, understands clearly that the locality recommendations are the suggested changes.

Upon a motion by Kim Payne to approve the *Recommendation for Approval of Functional Classification Changes Proposed by the Virginia Department of Transportation*, seconded by Jack Hobbs, the *Recommendation* was unanimously approved as presented.

5. Opportunity for Public Comment

Chairman John Sharp opened the Public Comment period at 4:19 p.m. No comments were received. Public Comment period closed at 4:20 p.m.

6. Election of Chair and Vice Chair

Bob White indicated Hugh Pendleton and Joan Foster were next in line to serve as Chair and Vice-Chair, respectively, for FY 2014.

Upon a motion by David Laurrell to accept the recommendations for the election of the Chair and Vice-Chair as presented, seconded by Kim Payne, the motion carried unanimously.

7. Matters from the Committee

At the request of the Chair John Sharp, LU agreed to give a presentation on projects at the University at the October meeting.

Chris Winstead, newly appointed district manager for the Lynchburg VDOT District, introduced himself and gave detail on his past experiences in related fields. Further, he reported on VDOT projects through the end of calendar year 2014 using \$116 million that have been planned to put into district transportation system.

The Commonwealth Transportation Board will again conduct nine public meetings across the state in October and November to give stakeholders the opportunity to review and provide comments on projects and programs to be included in the Fiscal Year 2015-2020 Six-Year Improvement Program, including highway, rail and public transportation initiatives. I will co-host he November 21 meeting at The Kirkley Hotel in Lynchburg with our local CTB representative(s) and the Department of Rail and Public Transportation. We want to build on the efforts during last year's fall meetings, and it is important that we hear from you and your constituents about those projects you feel are the highest priority for the state's limited transportation funds.

These meetings will consist of an open house format from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. where attendees can review materials produced by agency staff and discuss specific projects or issues. Following the open house, an opportunity will be provided for comments from the public and transportation stakeholders. Written comments may also be submitted during this informal session, or they may be mailed or e-mailed until December 6, 2013. As we did last year, meeting materials will be available on the web at http://www.virginiadot.org/2013fallmeetings starting October 22nd. The Fall Transportation Meeting Schedule is attached.

Representatives from the Department of Transportation, Department of Rail and Public Transportation, Office of Transportation Public-Private Partnerships and the Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment will be in attendance to provide information on current initiatives.


