1. Call to Order

Stan Goldsmith, Chair, called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm.

2. Approval of the May 15, 2014 Meeting Minutes

3. Discussion with Nick Donohue, Deputy Secretary of Transportation, Commonwealth of Virginia

4. Status Report and Discussion of the Central Virginia Long range Transportation Plan Year 2040 Update

Bob White introduced the project and reviewed the project status.

Vlad Gavrilovic reviewed the new state and federal evaluation frameworks, specifically MAP-21, V-Trans 2040, and HB-2. Vlad discussed what these programs and pieces of legislation mean to the region and their importance regarding transportation funding and improvements to planning and programming.

Additionally, Vlad discussed and updated the group in further detail regarding the CVLRTP 2040 update.

Bill Wuensch reviewed and discussed the CVLRTP 2040 project evaluation framework in a review of the goals, objectives, and evaluation criteria including the proposed indicators and weighting scale. Additionally, Bill presented a sample evaluation matrix using current projects from the CVLRTP 2035, which indicated how these projects would be rated utilizing the proposed evaluation framework for the CVLRTP 2040 update. Lastly, Bill reviewed the next steps and completion schedule for the update.
