VDOT has requested that the CVMPO consider three amendments to the 2015-2018 CVTIP.

The first two pertain to additions regarding debt service on projects relating to Woodys Lake Road (State Route 682) in Amherst County and Odd Fellows Road in Lynchburg City.

The third pertains to the Waterlick Road Congestion and Safety Improvements project, which successfully received HB2 (now SmartScale) funding is also being added to the CVTIP.

5. Presentation on VTrans2025 Multimodal Transportation Plan (VMTP) Draft Recommendations

The Virginia Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment, alongside local stakeholders, has developed draft recommendations for the VTrans2025 Multimodal Transportation Plan (VMTP). The VMTP 2025 Needs for Corridors of Statewide Significance (CoSS), Regional Networks and Urban Development Areas (UDAs) were developed in 2015. These 2025 Needs were consolidated across different travel markets and divided into three tiers. The 2025 draft project recommendations for the Tier 1 needs have been developed.

These draft recommendations were presented by the VTrans consulting team to the Central Virginia Transportation Technical Committee (TTC) and at a public open house on January 12, 2017.

6. Update on Regional Congestion Survey

In 2013, Local Government Council staff conducted a survey of where Region 2000 residents met congestion points in order to assist transportation officials responsible for planning and improving roads, transit, multi modal means, and other features of the regional transportation system. The survey results serve as a "street view" for transportation engineers and planners in Region 2000 to help them be aware of transportation challenges encountered by citizens on a daily basis.

This document is available to local officials as a planning tool to assist in future updates to the Transportation Improvement Program and Central Virginia Long Range Transportation Plan (an update is occurring in 2017). Because of this, the regional congestion survey is being updated, and will be open for public input during the month of February.

1. Call to Order

Will Mays, Vice-Chair, called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm.

2. Approval of Minutes – July 21, 2016 Meeting

Upon a motion by Bonnie Svrcek to approve the minutes of the July 21, 2016 meeting, seconded by Jack Hobbs, this motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. Adoption of Resolution Supporting Transportation Alternatives Applications from Localities within the MPO Boundary

Upon a motion by Jack Hobbs, and seconded by John Sharp, the resolution was approved unanimously.

4. Adoption of Resolutions Supporting Transportation Alternatives Applications from Localities within the MPO Boundary

Upon a motion by Dean Rodgers, seconded by Jack Hobbs, the Amherst County Transportation Alternatives Resolution was approved unanimously.

Upon a motion by Bonnie Svrcek, and seconded by Jack Hobbs, the City of Lynchburg Transportation Alternatives Resolution was approved unanimously.

5. Update and Discussion of the Lynchburg Regional Connectivity Study

Shannon Valentine explained that the Lynchburg Regional Connectivity Study ties connectivity and transportation to economic development. The idea behind this particular study was to have this data and research done at the regional (instead of local or state). She added that Rick Youngblood from VDOT, has served as the project manager for the studies, and Bob White has served as the liaison between this study and the CEDS study.

The study highlights three broad themes, with eight strategy areas:

- 1. Labor Market & Intra-Regional Connectivity
 - Place making
 - Local Bottlenecks
 - Transit & Transportation Demand Management
- 2. Inter-Regional Connectivity
 - Intercity Passenger Rail
 - Air Service Development
 - Access on Key Highway Corridors
 - Cargo Oriented Development
- 3. Digital Connectivity
 - Broadband Coverage

Rick Youngblood reported that VTrans is a state-wide multimodal plan for the state transportation system, and is utilized as part of the process for Smart Scale. One of the key components of VTrans is creating sub-area analysis, which is a more micro look at a particular urbanized area.

Mr. Youngblood advised that the study is a living document, intended to evolve and be updated as necessary. The final draft should be released in December.

John Sharp made a recommendation that the public comment opportunity come earlier on the meeting agenda.

Proposed additions to CVTIP 2015-2018

To be considered by the CVMPO at its meeting on January 19, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. in the large conference room of the Region 2000 Local Government Council offices at 828 Main Street, 12th Floor.

There are two additions regarding debt service on projects relating to Woodys Lake Road (State Route 682) in Amherst County and Odd Fellows Road in Lynchburg City.

- The TIP amendments are to add GARVEE Debt Service UPCs (Universal Project Codes) to the current TIP for two UPCs currently programmed with GARVEE Bond Proceeds
- These TIP amendments are only for projects in which there have been no previous payments toward GARVEE Debt Service principal and interest. These projects are scheduled to have their first GARVEE Debt Service payments toward the principal and interest supporting the GARVEE Bond Proceeds in March 2017. The GARVEE Debt Service UPCs must be included in the current MPO TIP and STIP to support those payments which is the basis of this request.
- For the GARVEE Construction UPCs, which are grouped, notation will be made in the comments section of the grouping tracking sheet identifying the GARVEE Debt Service UPC and the applicable GARVEE Debt Service interest costs.
- In the past, planned obligations and conversion related to payment toward GARVEE
 Debt Service principal and interest were reflected on the GARVEE Debt Service UPC
 and the sum of those payments over the life of the project accounted for the total cost
 of the Debt Service project. This created a "double counting" issue as costs related to
 the GARVEE Debt Service principal were also reflected on the GARVEE Construction
 UPC.
- To avoid the "double counting" issue in the future, TIP amendments will reflect
 planned obligation and conversion of GARVEE Debt Service principal on the GARVEE
 Construction UPC along with any other planned obligations of pay as you go funds
 associated with the project. The GARVEE Debt Service UPC will only reflect planned
 conversion of AC related to GARVEE Debt Service interest. The sum of all interest over
 the life of the project is reflected as the total cost.
- The program note for each UPC will make reference to the corresponding GARVEE Construction or Debt Service UPC. For the GARVEE Construction UPC, the program note will delineate between planned obligations in each year for pay as you go funds versus GARVEE Debt Service principal costs.
