WHEREAS, the Central Virginia Transportation Planning Organization (CVTPO), supports improving safety along the region's roadways for all users; and

WHEREAS, 220 people were killed and 1,680 people were seriously injured in crashes in the CVPDC region between 2018 and 2023; and

WHEREAS reducing or eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries requires a collaborative approach that recognizes humans make mistakes, that death and serious injury along the region's roadways is unacceptable, and that taking proactive measures to advance safety can have positive impacts on increasing safety; and

WHEREAS, the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law established the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) sets a vision of zero deaths and serious injuries and a goal to reduce roadway fatalities and serious injuries by half by 2045; and

WHEREAS, the Central Virginia Safety Action Plan – Safe Streets for All was developed through a comprehensive stakeholder participation and data-driven evaluation to advance programs and projects to improve safety along the region's roadways for all users,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Central Virginia Transportation Planning Organization does hereby adopt the Central Virginia Safety Action Plan – Safe Streets for All and supports the goal to reduce roadway fatalities and serious injuries along our region's roadways by fifty (50) percent by 2045.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Central Virginia Transportation Planning Organization recommends approval and adoption of the regional transportation safety plan by the Central Virginia Planning District Commission.
