WHEREAS, THE Central Virginia Metropolitan Planning Organization (CVMPO) adopted the Central Virginia Long Range Transportation Plan, Year 2030 on December 8, 2005; and

WHEREAS, THE CVMPO is Federally-mandated to update its long range transportation plan every five years; and

WHEREAS, THE Central Virginia Long Range Plan-Year 2035 (Plan) provides a blueprint for a transportation system that is vital to Central Virginia's growth and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, THE Plan includes regional multi-modal transportation goals and suggested strategies as well as a set of transportation projects to advance the growth and quality of life if Central Virginians; and

WHEREAS, THE Plan was developed in conjunction with an extensive public involvement effort, consideration of financial constraints, environmental, socio-economic, and economic impacts, and consideration of the transportation and land use concerns of local, state, and federal governments;
